You may also note that the majority of the programs will be held for a limited period of time (typically for 2-3 hours) and will include the use of a public address system and will be monitored by staff members from the Office of Student Life to ensure that sound levels are appropriate and do not negatively impact classrooms and offices in the vicinity of the event. The list also includes events that may be held on days/times not impacted by the Amplified Sound Policy. These have been included to better inform the campus community of large-scale events that have already been calendared to decrease the possibility of cross-programming (the scheduling of multiple events on the same date/time). This information may also be shared with our neighbors in the surrounding community who may want to attend these programs or to at least be aware of any potential impact.

Requests for exceptions to this policy must be submitted in writing to Dr. Susan H. Payment, Director of Student Life no less than two weeks (14 calendar days) prior to the proposed date of the event. A committee comprised of representatives from the student body, faculty and staff of the College of Charleston will convene to review the request and will notify the requestor in writing of the committee's decision. An Event Planning Form must be completed and all prior approvals for the proposed event (space reservation, Public Safety staffing, etc.) must be received before the proposed event is submitted to the committee for review.
